## 3.3 Identifying dental caries



### A healthy mouth

Pink gums indicate a healthy blood supply. Teeth are not discoloured.

Upper and lower teeth meet each other when biting.



#### First stage of caries

The upper incisors develop a dull white band (demineralisation) along the gum line, which usually goes undetected by the parents or carers. This first stage of caries is called a white spot lesion and is reversible.

Refer to an oral health professional. Encourage good oral hygiene practices.

### Early stages of caries

Some brown spots on teeth, redness and swelling of gums.

Refer to an oral health professional. Encourage good oral hygiene practices.



# Advanced stages of caries

Blackened areas and very red and inflamed gums.

This level of caries can lead to the removal of teeth. Refer to an oral health professional.
