Establishing a toothbrushing routine early

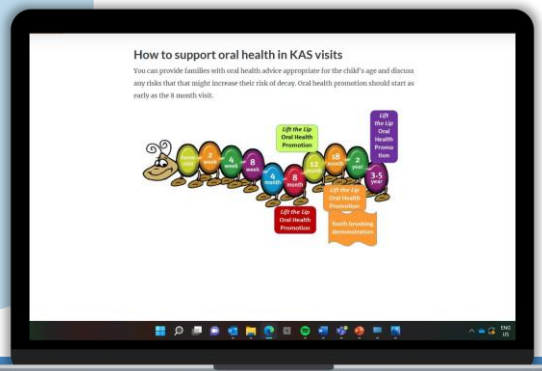
Incorporating oral health in the Key Ages and Stages framework
