Position Purpose:

As part of the Day Surgery Nursing team, this role is responsible for providing quality nursing care for all patients requiring dental care in the Day Surgery Unit (DSU) from pre-admission through to discharge.





Role Accountabilities:

Role Specific

- Provide a high standard of patient care in accordance with the Day Surgery Unit's policies/procedures and the ACORN standards.
- Provide clinical support to all dental assistants and clinicians during the perioperative period.
- Advance airway management skills.
- Record anaesthetic clinical indicators.
- Maintain complete and accurate documentation of the patients' perioperative period.
- Participate in medical responses.
- Assist with preop and post op calls for patients attending DSU.
- Reviewing patient medical questionaries' and tracking medical information from other hospitals/clinics to facilitate patient care in Day Surgery.
- Mentor undergraduate nursing students and new students when required.
- Other duties as directed within scope of role.

- Currency of Infection Control policies and processes.
- Current BLS/ALS qualifications.
- Knowledge of current ACORN standards.

Desirable

Knowledge of DHSV and public oral health.

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills and the ability to liaise effectively with all stakeholders' levels.
- Experience with patient management systems.

- Experience in a public health sectorenvironment.
