Position Purpose:

As part of the Day Surgery Nursing team, this role is responsible for safe administration of anaesthesia and sedation and providing high quality nursing care for all patients requiring dental care in the Day Surgery Unit (DSU).





Role Accountabilities:

Role Specific

- Provide a high standard of patient care in accordance with the Day Surgery Unit's policies/procedures and the ACORN standards.
- Provide clinical support to all dental assistants and clinicians during the perioperative period.
- Advance airway management skills.
- Maintain complete and accurate documentation of the patients' perioperative period.
- Participate in medical responses and ensure all equipment pertaining to the administration of Anaesthesia is correctly maintained, checked and available for use while working in partnership with Medical, Nursing and Allied Health team to ensure best outcomes for patients.
- Participate in the preop and post op calls for DSU patients.
- This position will work between Anaesthetics and PACU- Stage 1 Recovery.
- Act up in the absence of the ANUM and ensure efficient and effective daily operations in the allocated area.
- Other duties as directed within scope of role.
