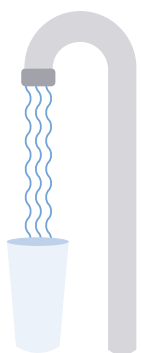


Victorian Action Plan to Prevent Oral Disease

Achievements and Progress for 2021-22

Camperdown water fluoridation plant was commissioned in February 2022 providing fluoridated drinking water to more than

Eat well, Drink well, Clean well tip card series for early childhood services was reviewed in November 2021.

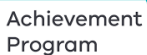
